Prague Radio Symphony Orchestra

One of the longest established Czech orchestras, the Prague Radio Symphony Orchestra (PRSO) is a creative and versatile ensemble at the forefront of Czech music making, and a popular guest ensemble at concert venues across the world. The orchestra's chief conductor is **Ondrej Lenárd**. The PRSO was established in 1926, three years after the foundation of the Czechoslovak Radio.

Airport – Clarion Congress Hotel Prague roughly 570 to 670 CZK (20–25 EUR)

Please beware that some taxi drivers charge passengers up to 100 CZK per km (regulated price is 28 CZK) if the price is shown to the client. Always check the price before entering the cab.

Currency exchange

The recommended way of changing your currency to CZK is ATM withdrawal. Unless you're changing large amounts (over a few hundred euros) or are charged a lot from your bank, it is the best option. When you do wish to obtain Czech Crowns at the exchange offices and booths, which are abundant in the centre, be sure you ask what the rate is first and how many CZK you will get for the amount you wish to exchange. It's a generally good idea to have this written down before handing over cash then there can be no dubiety over misinterpreting what's said. Please beware that some exchange offices offers good exchange rates but charge huge commission fees (up to 30%) unless you are VIP customer. Other offices will have printed good exchange rates but again only for VIP.

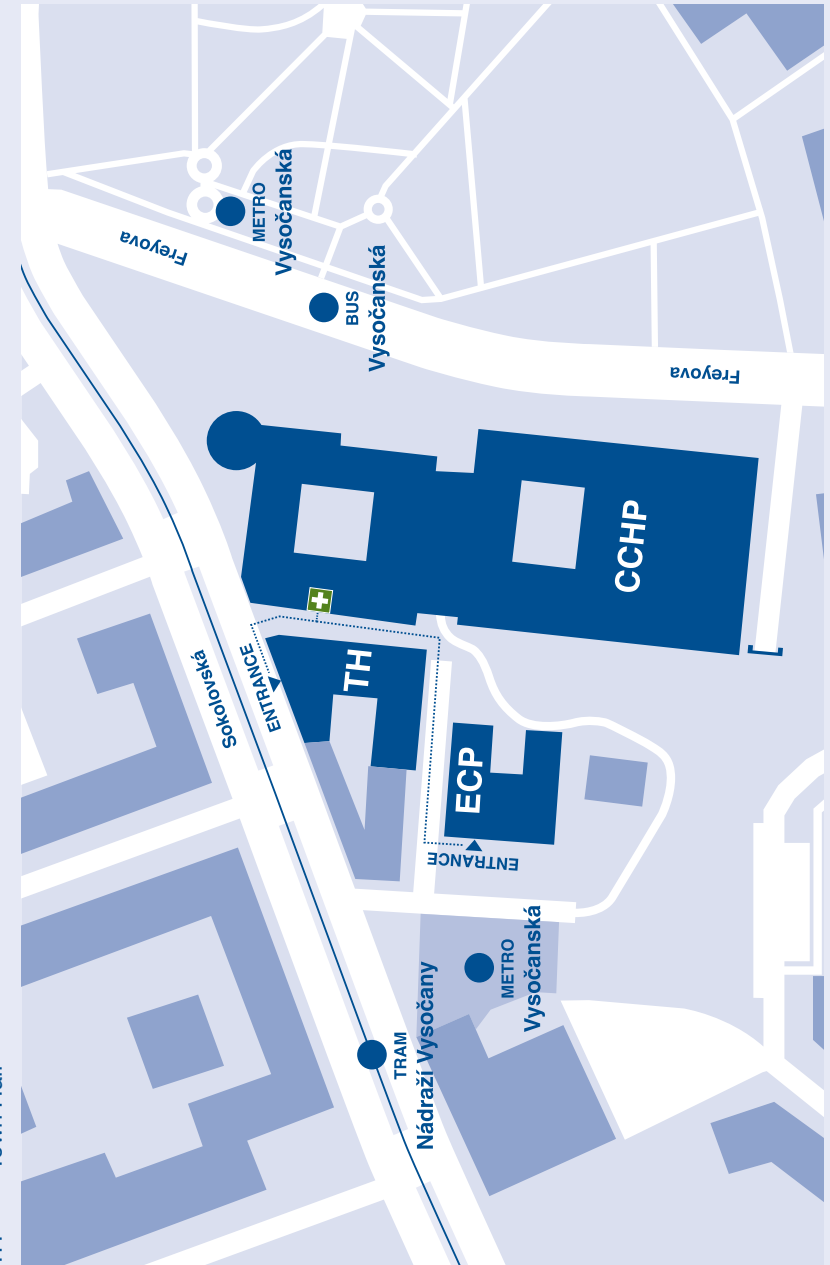

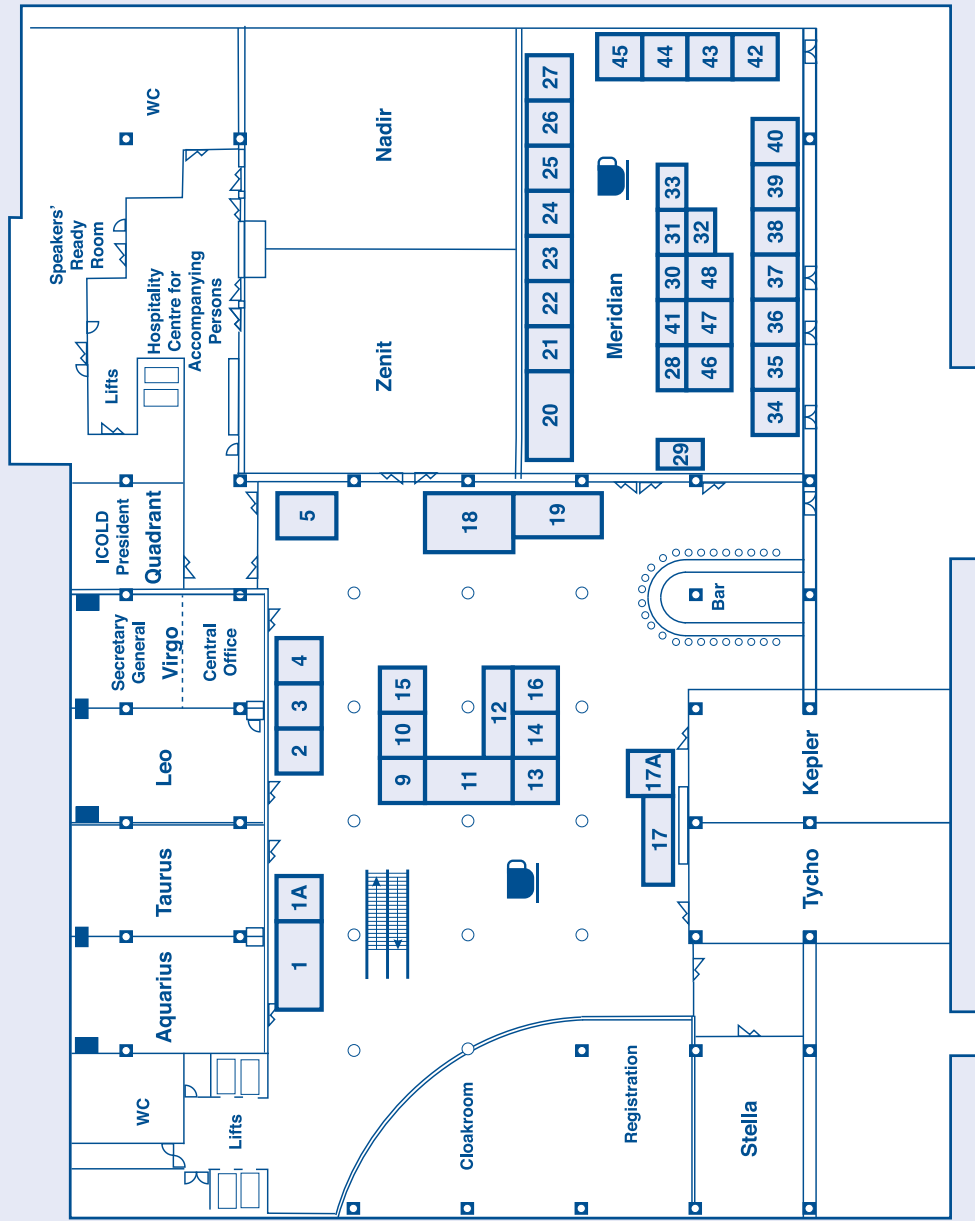
